A slum has around 350+ families and around 500+ children and most of them lack facilities like Electricity and toilets. The Iblur slum alone has 107 huts inside. Currently, 389 people are residing in these huts. According to our survey, there is always 2-5% of the floating population in all the communities. As on January 26th 2019, the Iblur community did not have any access to toilets and electricity.

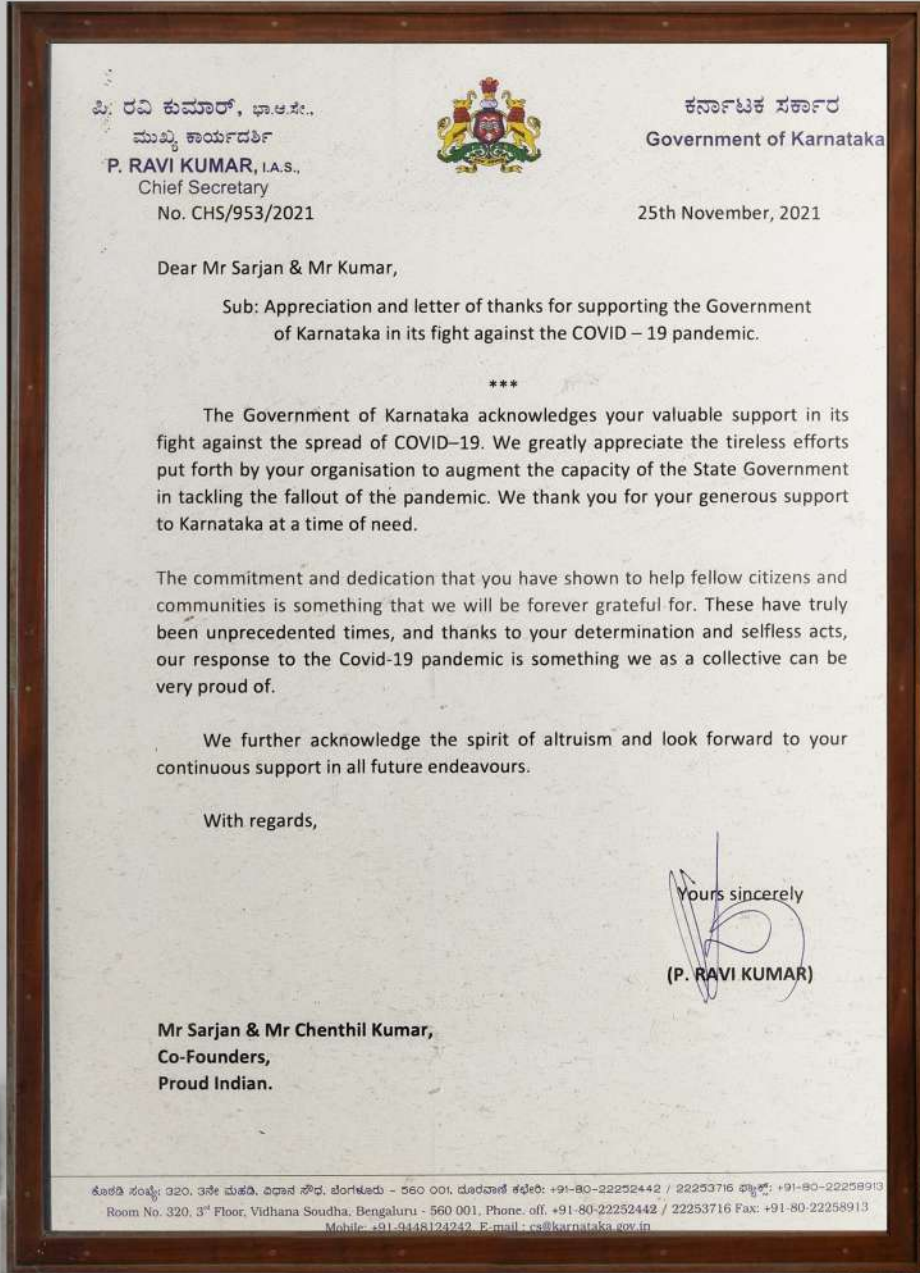

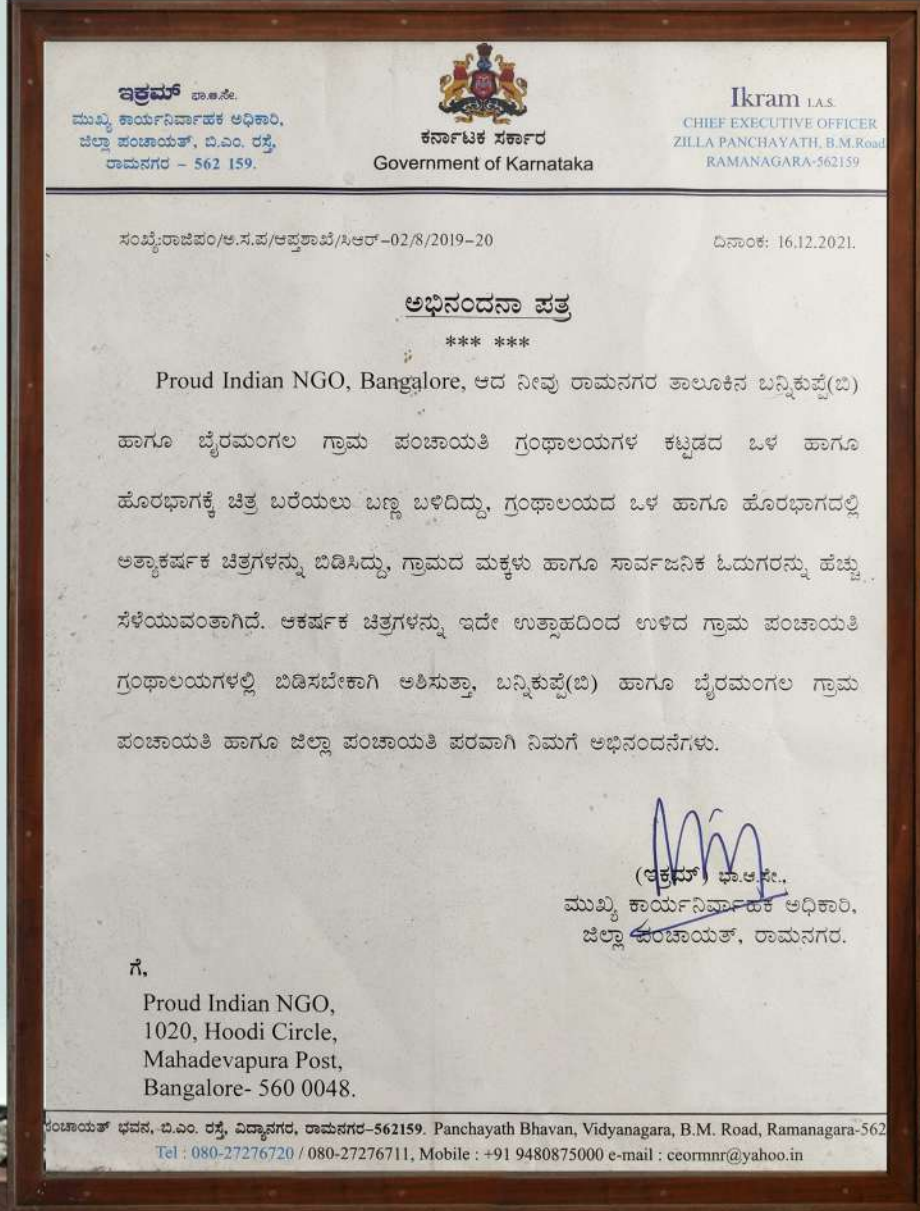
